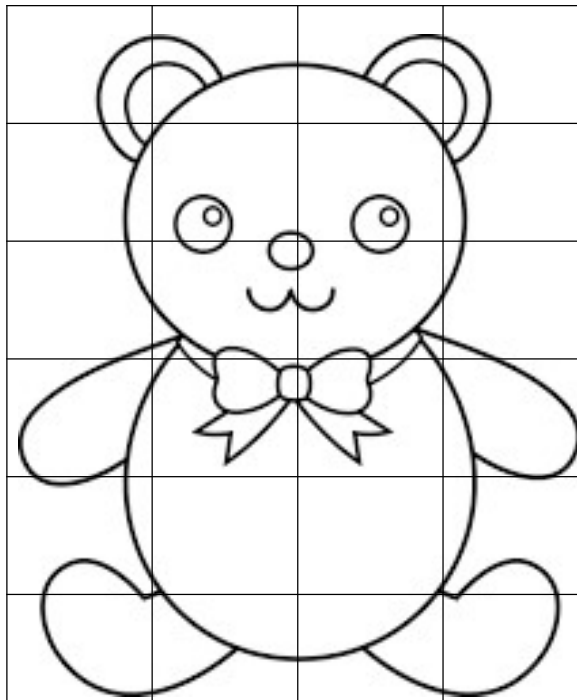


Scaled Agile Exercise

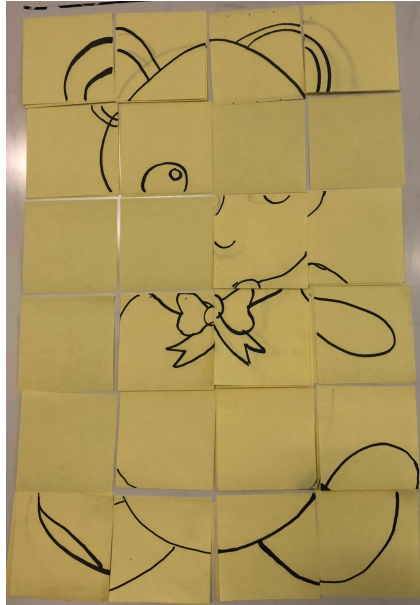
CSCI 3300/CSCI 5300

Draw one square from this picture on a post-it note. Do not talk to anyone.

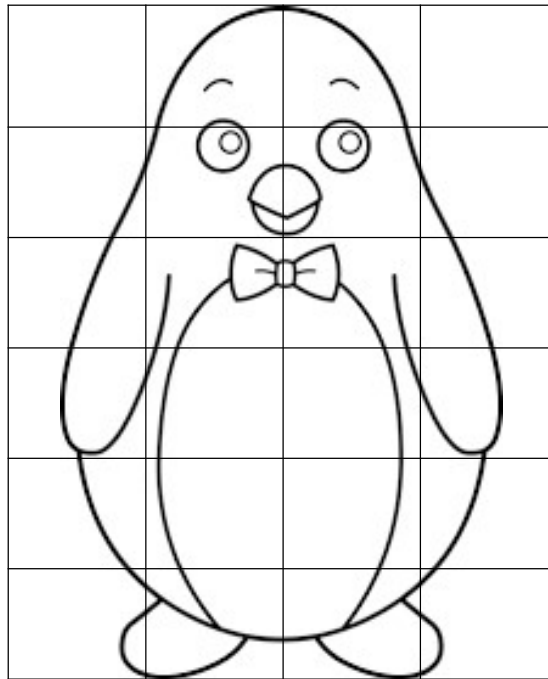


Put your square on the grid on the board.

End result

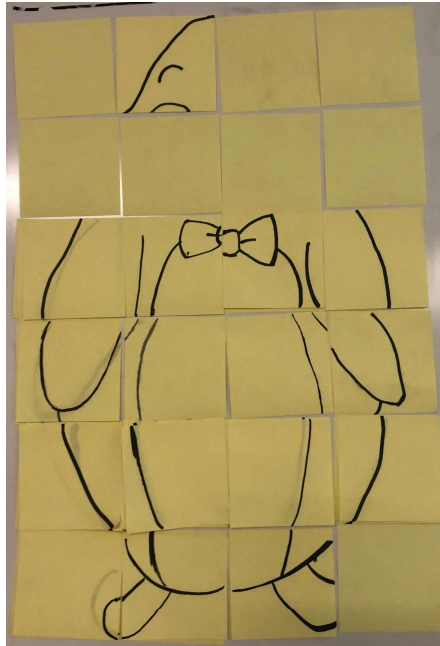


Draw one square from this picture on a post-it note. You can talk to your team.

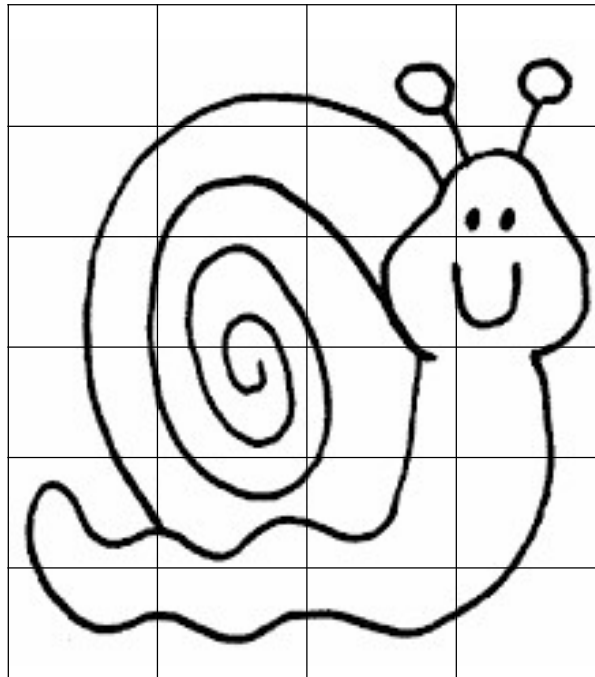


Put your square on the grid on the board.

End result

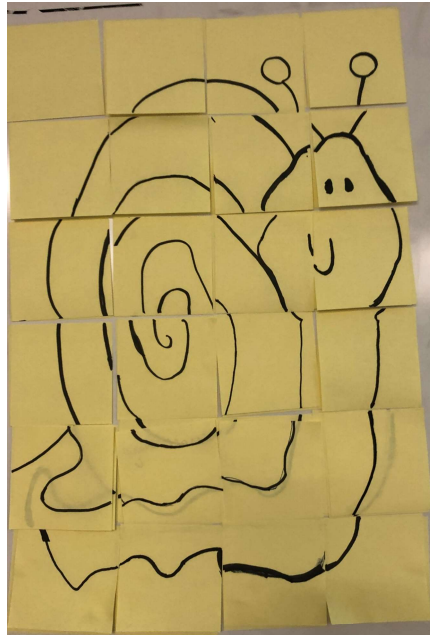


Select one person from your team to represent you. Selected representatives, get together and discuss your how your teams will proceed.

What do we learn from this exercise?

(class came up with the following conclusions)

- Communication
 - is key to delivering quality result
 - Helps reduce redundant work
 - Takes time
- Having a leader to discuss with other team reduced time
- Expect things to not work at integration time
- Integration planning would be useful
- Having a leader of the representatives would have reduced planning time
- Planning is important
- Each team member knew exactly what to do in a self-organized way
- Clear definition of "done" is helpful
